

# RJ Vinedos MDZ Malbec 2018

This 100% Malbec showcases the best and classic qualities of Mendoza. The nose comes alive with hints of mocha, blueberry, cherries, and rose petals that lead to a rich mouth feel held up by a good structure and smooth tannins. This fruit driven wine showcases boysenberry, blackberry, cocoa and cola nut flavors on the palate. The finish is long and smooth with hints of dried herbs and cedar that encapsulate the bright and vibrant wine.

RJ Vinedos is a family owned winery run by it's founder, Raul Joffre, and his four daughters. The winery began in 1996 when Raul purchased and refurbished a traditional cement tank winery in the Perdriel region of Lujan de Cuyo and a small vineyard in the Los Sauces region of the Uco Valley. They now have 60 hectares in the Uco Valley as well as holdings in Alto Agrelo and up north in the Calchaquíes Valley, Salta. Their vineyards are sustainably farmed, and no chemicals are used in either the vineyards or the winery. Winemaker Sebastián San Martín has a minimalistic approach. He believes in letting the grapes have their own voice and looks for purity of fruit with little intervention. They produce the Reunion and MDZ wines as well as a series of reserve wines.
